

Covid Protocols for Face-to-Face Lessons

1. Instructors will be masked at all times and we prefer for all students to mask. We ask families to consider CDC guidance and their instructor's preferences when choosing whether or not to mask.
2. Instructors will keep social distance whenever possible. Primary teaching will be done from a distance but closer contact is allowable when needed.
3. Each student and instructor will sanitize their hands before and after each lesson.
4. Families are expected to sanitize the keys and lesson area before each lesson.
5. Instructors will coordinate with families to move to virtual lessons when:
 - Anyone in a family has tested positive for Covid, has had known exposure to COVID, or is quarantined.
 - Anyone in a family exhibits any symptoms of illness.

This may require scheduling at a different time due to an instructor's virtual availability.
