

Protocols for Returning to Face-to-Face Lessons

1. All students and instructors must be masked with mask over the nose at all times. Any parents or family members in the vicinity of the lesson must also be masked.
2. Instructors will keep social distance whenever possible. Primary teaching will be done from a distance but closer contact is allowable when necessary.
3. Student's and instructor's hands will be sanitized before and after each lesson.
4. Families are expected to sanitize the keys and lesson area before each lesson.
5. Instructors will coordinate with families to move to virtual lessons when:
 - A family has been traveling or has other extensive exposure risk.
 - Anyone in a family has had known exposure to COVID or is quarantined.
 - Anyone in a family exhibits any symptoms of illness.

This may require scheduling at a different time due to an instructor's virtual availability.

6. Once a student has returned to face-to-face lessons, he/she may not flip-flop the format week-to-week except in the case of potential exposure or illness. (Long-term changes can be made if needed or desired.)
